- 2. Communism is found to be the weakest force on the political horizon. The few Communist gatherings are usually held in the offices of the <u>Tribuna Gaucha</u>, which paper is itself in such difficult financial straits that it is likely to cease publication shortly.
- 3. The strongest current is, as might be expected in the home state of Getúlio Vargas, the "Queremista" (pro-Vargas) movement. It is anticipated that the "Queremistas" will conduct an extensive campaign against President Dutra, but it is unlikely that they will attempt any sudden thrust against the state government of Walter Jobim.\*
